The Bensen House

The Bensen House, sometimes called the *Grant Historical House*, or the *1916 House* is a historic home located at 5795 U.S. Route 1, Grant, Florida. Built in 1916 by Atley Bensen for his wife Clara, the home has been restored and features a collection of antiques and furniture representative of its beginnings. It now serves as a museum and home to the Grant Historical Society.
